United Space School 2020 What to Bring

The following is a list of items that you will need to bring with you. Keep in mind that Houston has a subtropical climate (35° to 40° Celsius and 80% to 100% humidity). You should wear lightweight, practical clothes. Always wear sun block (SPF 30 minimum) whenever outside. It is very easy for visitors from more temperate climates to get burned and overheated. Avoid the summer sun when you can. Also to keep in mind; southeast Texas is subject to drenching rain in the summer. Students spend the majority of the time in school dress. *You should only need a few changes of casual clothes*.

*NOTE: it is best <u>not</u> to bring brand new shoes. Break in your shoes before you get here so you will not get blisters. Sport shoes/trainers are not appropriate footwear for school, but you may wear them during free time.

- you can bring a personal computer or tablet, but it is not necessary

HOST HOMES

Personal care products: shampoo, soap, toothpaste, deodorant/antiperspirant, etc. A small gift for your host family that is indicative of your culture or interests. This does not need to be expensive.
